What you need to know for the event

- Proper golf attire.
- Golf clubs, balls etc.
- Vehicle transportation, please carpool, if you are driving alone, please reach out as we could find another arrangement.
- Plan your route, maps will be provided on attachment.
- Cash for contests approximately \$60.
- Swim trunks, as we want you to take advantage of St. Eugene hotel amenities; Casino, swimming pool, hot-tubs, steam showers, sauna.
- Your Integrity is needed: this is a yearly event; we want to YOU to come back every year...

Recommended departure from Calgary is 6:00am as for the Edmonton groups add an additional 3 hours. It will take you approximately 4.5 hours from Calgary, this will provide time for traffic delays, pit stops, road-side turnouts, petrol stations, pee breaks and even number 2's.

- \$\$ 10 Deuce Pot; 3 days (Monday to Wednesday).
- \$\$ 10 Golf Ball Challenge; 4 days (Sunday to Wednesday).

- Hole Challenges; Closest-to the pin, closest-to the pin on second shot, long putt, long drive contests.
- Livermore Invitational Trophy – Stableford Format - we will assist scoring; scores will be posted at the end of all rounds on WhatsApp (Sam Livermore will assist).
- Hal Johnson and Joanne MacLeod Trophy – 3 Putt Tag.
- TSN “Shot of the Tournament” – All will Vote at the closing dinner.
- **Optional** – cost \$35 with a Par 3 Challenge; 9 holes of play – includes entry fee, hotdog, water or pop and fries –and award of “Eryn Geddes Award” Cash payout to the top teams.
